Association between Depression, Anxiety, Quality of Life and Satisfaction with Life Among Children of Divorced Couples

Abstract

Objective: The aim of this study is to identify the association between depression, anxiety and quality of life (QOL) among children of divorced couples.

Methods: A random sample comprised of 198 individuals, 07 to above 20 years of age. An organized self-report questionnaire based on 6. Segments was administered; 1. Consent form, 2. Demographic information sheet of participants, 3. Beck anxiety inventory (BAI), 4. Beck depression inventory (BDI), 5. Satisfaction with life-scale, 6. Quality of life Scale.

Results: The current research reveals that the Beck anxiety inventory has a non-significantly positive correlation with the Beck depression inventory (r=.77, p>.05) and a non-significantly negative correlation in Satisfaction with life scale (r=-.26, p>.05), and has a significantly negative correlation with Quality of life scale (r=-.026, p<.05). Beck depression inventory has a non-significant negative correlation with satisfaction with life scale (r=-.279, p>.05) and has a significant negative correlation with Quality of life scale (r=-.015, p<.05). Satisfaction with life scale has a non-significant positive correlation with Quality of life scale (r=-.340, p>.05).

Conclusion: Analysis of the current research study indicates that divorce is a predictive factor in the life of children who have separated parents. Divorce is a strong factor which affects the level of depression, anxiety and quality of life and satisfaction with life.

Separation is a terminology which is not only considered as a stigma for a female it also affects the life of a male as well, but the individuals which are affected most by this term are the children who don't have understanding about what's going around the lives of their parents. This includes all physical, emotional, social aspects of an individual's life. According to Seidl (2004), Quality of life usually is described in terms of a subjective notion or belief which is multidimensional, also is described and systematized with difficulty and finally of sophisticated operationalization. It is basically described as an individual understands of their status in their lives along a societal and cultural context in association with their objectives, standards and expectations.

As indicated by Center for Disease Prevention Control, in 2008 the marriage rate was 7.1, and the separation rate was 3.5 among 1000 individuals. Moreover, these days in 2011 the cost of marriage was 6.8 and the separation cost transformed into 3.6. Cavanagh et al. Methods

Current research is based on quantitative research comprised of purposive sampling technique for data collection. Data was collected through the administration of standardized scales i.e., WHOQOL scale developed by World health organization in 1995 and revised in 2012 based on 32 items, Beck Depression Inventory-by ARON, T-Beck(21 Items Scale-1996) Test-retest reliability 0.92 Phan T, Carter O, Adams C, et al. 2013, Beck Anxiety Inventory(ARON, T-Beck, 21 Items), Satisfaction with life scale by Pavot, W., & Diener, E. (2008), The coefficient alpha for the scale has ranged from .79 to .89 was determined in 2013. For the analysis of data inferential statistics was used, mean, standard deviation, correlation and linear regression were estimated with the used of SPSS 21.0 version.

Results

The Table below shows the impact of Beck Anxiety Inventory and Beck Depression Inventory on Life Satisfaction and quality of life. The R^2 value of .09 revealed that the predictors explained 9% variance in the outcome variable with F (2, 195) = 8.829, P<.001. The findings revealed that Beck Anxiety inventory has non-significant negative effect on Satisfaction with life (B=-.114, P>.05). Whereas Beck Depression Inventory has non-

The table revealed that Beck anxiety inventory has non-significant positive correlation with Beck depression inventory (r=.77, p>.05) and has non-significant negative correlation with Satisfaction with life scale ($\mathbb{R}=-.26$, p>.05), and has significant negative correlation with Quality of life scale (r=-.026, p<.05). Beck depression inventory has non-significant negative correlation with satisfaction with life scale (r=-.279, p>.05) and has significant negative correlation with Quality of life scale (r=-.015, p<.05). The correlation of Beck depression inventory and Beck anxiety inventory is negative, which depicts that with the increment of depression and anxiety quality of life and satisfaction with life decreases in all these circumstances divorce plays a major role.

Conclusion

To conclude, it is illustrated from the results that divorce is a major predictive factor for the depression, anxiety, quality of life and satisfaction with life. Children who belong to separated families may face dissatisfaction with life, low quality of life, depression and anxiety. Results indicate that divorce is a variable which has adverse impact on lives of the children from separated parents. The results explored that level of anxiety and depression that are linear in relationship. Current research explored that a healthy individual is nourished by both parents as they play a vital role in the development of children's personalities. Current research demands more

research in this area to find out factors which are responsible for divorce among couples.
